Directions to Paul Lader's home in Wenonah, NJ

If you have GPS in your car or on your iphone, enter "8 East Cherry St, Wenonah, NJ 08090."

Otherwise:

From Philadelphia: Take the Ben Franklin bridge to New Jersey. As you leave the bridge, bear right and get on I-676 south. Stay on the highway until it merges & turns into Route 42 south (as if you were heading to the AC Expressway). Take Exit 13 to the right, which will get you to Route 55 south. Continue on Route 55 for about 3-4 miles to Exit 56B (Route 47 north). Take this exit; as soon as you leave the exit ramp, you will come to a traffic light. Make a left at this light on to Bankbridge Road.

Stay on Bankbridge Road and go through one traffic light. Continue further, and Bankbridge will end at a T intersection. Make a right, and you will immediately reach the traffic light at Mantua Avenue (there will be a Wells Fargo bank on the left far corner). Make a left onto Mantua Avenue, and continue several blocks, proceeding up a hill and past a big church on the left. Look for South Clinton Avenue on the left, which runs along the borough park. Make a left onto South Clinton; proceed on South Clinton along the park. At the end of the park you will reach East Cherry Street. Our house is on the corner immediately to the right.

Parking is permitted along the borough park.

From the Walt Whitman Bridge: As you leave the bridge, stay straight and continue on I-76/I-676 south until it turns into Route 42 south. Then same as above.

From Central & Northern New Jersey: Proceed south on I-295. After passing Exit 28 (Route 168), bear right and take the long jug handle which keeps you on 295; however, as you get to the bottom of the jug handle ramp, bear left (Exit 1A) and get on Route 42 south. Take Exit 13 to Route 55 south. Same as above.

From the Commodore Barry Bridge: after leaving the bridge, stay straight onto US 322 east. Continue east on 322 for approximately 7 miles until you reach Route 45. Make a left onto Route 45 north and continue for approximately 3-4 miles. Look for a Home Depot & Kohl's on the left, followed by a large strip mall. At the next light, the Mantua Post office will be at the far corner to the right; make a right onto Mantua Boulevard. Proceed through the next traffic light, after which you will reach an uncontrolled 5-way intersection, with a Methodist Church to the right. Make a 45 degree left onto Mantua Avenue (yes, that's correct-- Mantua Boulevard to Mantua Avenue) and continue straight for about a mile. After crossing the railroad tracks, the borough park will be to the right. Make a right onto South Clinton Avenue. Same as above.

If anyone takes the **New Jersey Turnpike south**, continue to Exit 2 and then take US 322 east. Then follow the same directions as above (from the Commodore Barry Bridge).
